

Admonition of Anne Garrett wife of Edmund

The condicon of this Obligacon is such that if the above bounden Elizabeth Garrett ye Lawful daughter Administrator of all and singular the goods chattalls and credits of Ann Garrett late of ye parish of Crick above mentioned wid deceased doe make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singuler the goods chattells and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of her the said Ann Garrett -----or into the hands and possession of any person or persons for her and the same soe made doe exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Archdeacon of Northton at or before the twelfth----- day of September next ensuing And the same goods chattells and credits and all other the goods chattells and credits of the said deceased at the time of her death which at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the said Elizabeth Garrett -----or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for her doe well and truly administer according to Law And further doe make or cause to be made a true and just attempt of her sd Adron* at or before ye twelfth ----day of June Anno Dom 1691 and all the rest and residue of the said goods chattells and credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrators attempt the same being first examined and allowed of by the Judge or Judges for the time being of the said Court shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively, as the said Judge or Judges, by his or their decree or sentence pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the late Act of Parliament made in the two and twentieth and three and twentieth yeares of the raigne of our late Sovereigne Ld King Charles the second (Instituted An Act for the better settling of Intestates Estates) shall limitt and appoint And if it shall hereafter appeare that any last will and Testament was made by the said deceased and the Executor or Executors therein named doe exhibit the same into the said Court making request to have it allowed and approved accordingly if the said Elizabeth Garrett ---- above bounden being thereunto required doe render and deliver the said Lres of Adcon* (approbacon of such Testament being first had and made) in the said Court. Then this Obligacon to be void and of none effect or else to remaine in full force and vertue.

 of Northton at or before the twelfth day of September next
 ensuing And the same goods chattels and credits and all other the goods chattels and credits
 of the said deceased at the time of her death which at any time after shall come to the
 hands or possession of the said Elizabeth Garret
 or into the hands and
 possession of any other person or persons for her do or well and truly administer
 according to Law And further do or cause to be made a true and just account
 of her administration at or before y^e twelfth day of June Anno Dni 1697
 and all the rest and residues of the said goods chattels and credits which shall be found
 remaining upon the said Administrators attempt the same being first examined and
 allowed of by the Judge or Judges for the time being of the said County shall deliver
 and pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Judge or Judges by his
 or their order or sentence be pursuant to the true intent and meaning of a late Act of
 Parliament made in the first and twentieth and twentieth year of the reign
 of late Sovereign King Charles the second (intituled An Act for the better
 settling of Intestate Estates) shall limit and appoint And if it shall hereafter
 appear that any last will and Testament was made by the said deceased and the
 Executor or Executors thereof have not exhibited the same into the said Court within
 request to have it allowed and approved attorneyly if the said Elizabeth Garret
 should be bound being thereunto required do render and deliver the said Inventory
 (approbation of such Testament being first had and made) in the said Court the said
 Obligation to be void and of none effect or else to remaine in full force and p^{er}petue
