Death of a Coal Master

Mr. and Mrs Shelah Garratt of Queens Cross died within a short time of each other on Sunday last. Mrs Garratt had been ailing for some two years, but it is only a few days since Mr. Garratt took to his bed. Mr. Garratt was a coal master of the old school and was succeeded in business by his son Alderman Job Garratt J.P twice mayor of Dudley. The late Mr. Garratt was 77 years of age. The funeral of the deceased lady and gentleman took place at the parish church on Thursday. The service was full choral.

The undertaker was Messrs A. J. Baird & Co. The coffin makers being Messrs W. Holland & Son.
